



## **Students Interested in Charleston Moves' Work Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)**

### **I'm a student younger than 18 years old and interested in volunteering for Charleston Moves. How can I participate?**

If you are under the age of 18 years old, we do need written permission from (and often, accompaniment by) your guardian to volunteer with us on an activity-by-activity basis to ensure your safety. Certain events for which we use volunteers, such as our annual gala, do not allow volunteers under 18. If you're younger than 18 years old and you'd like to volunteer for Charleston Moves, please reach out directly to our [info@charlestonmoves.org](mailto:info@charlestonmoves.org) address and copy your guardian so we can all coordinate together.

### **I'm a student between the ages of 18-20 years old and interested in volunteering for Charleston Moves. How can I participate?**

Please make sure to sign up for our volunteer list [HERE!](#) If you are under the age of 21, you cannot volunteer for our annual gala, but we'd love your help for bicycle and pedestrian counts, tabling opportunities, and other activities.

### **I'm coordinating a build project for class credit, a scout troop, etc. Can I work with Charleston Moves?**

All build/demonstration projects must first be coordinated with and permitted by the public or private property owner, not Charleston Moves.

### **I'm writing a research paper and would like to talk to a staff member of Charleston Moves. How can I schedule an interview or get more data/information?**
